ERC Expert Group



The Expert Group to support applicants in ERC calls was established in January 2021 based on the Joint Declaration of Charles University and the Academy of Sciences of the Czech Republic. It consists of a **coordinator and 10 members** from 3 scientific domains according to the ERC structure. Its task is to support ERC applicants at the national level in cooperation with the Prague Technology Centre.

The Expert Group, headed by **Prof. Zdeněk Strakoš**, organizes many activities every year to support ERC applicants - the ERC National Information Day, workshops for applicants, mock interviews for applicants, workshops for project managers and institutions to support ERC applicants and individual consultations.
